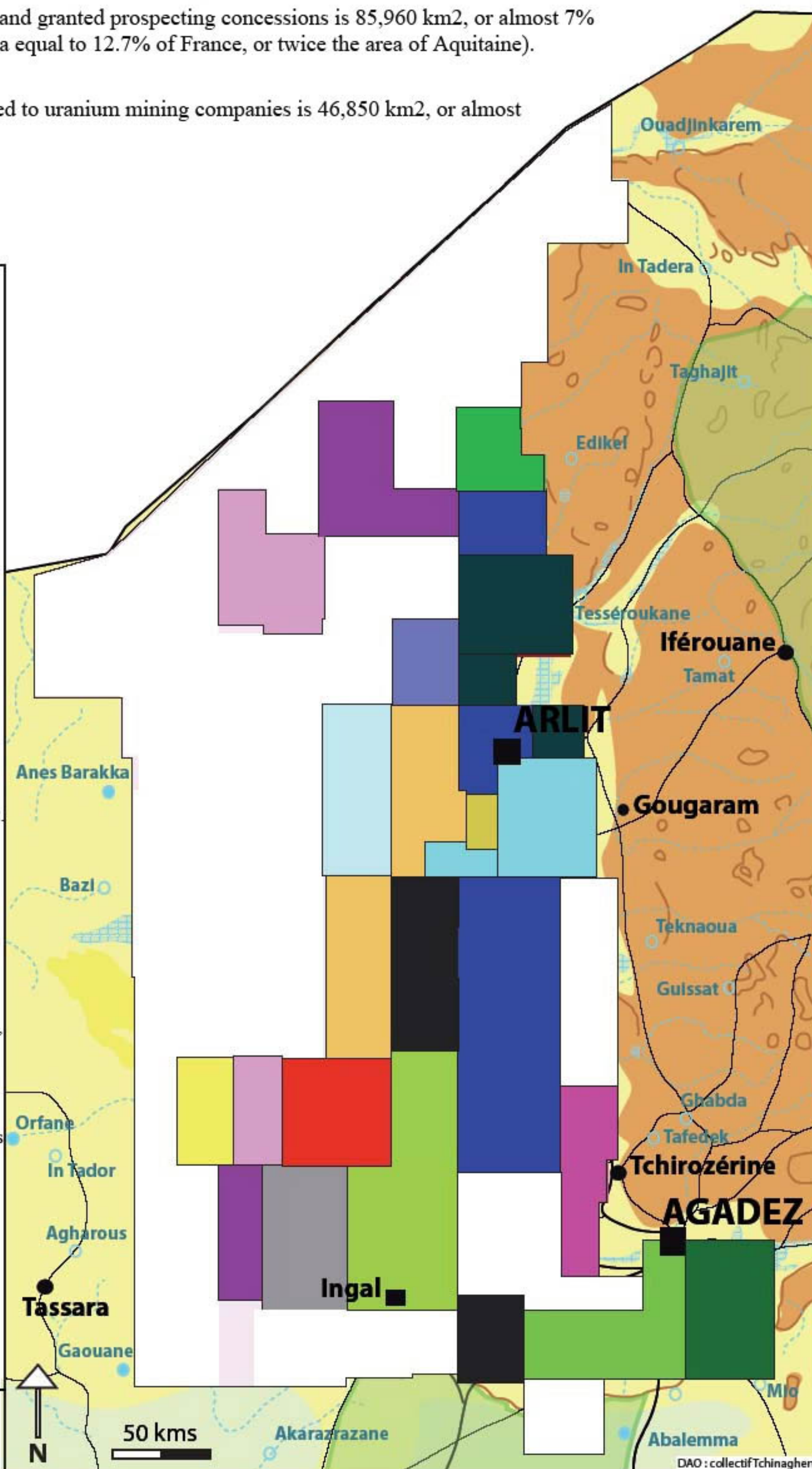


Nuclear colonialism and seizure of agricultural lands and Tuareg grazing areas by foreign companies

The surface area for requested and granted prospecting concessions is 85,960 km², or almost 7% of Nigeria's territory (or an area equal to 12.7% of France, or twice the area of Aquitaine).

The surface area already granted to uranium mining companies is 46,850 km², or almost 4% of Nigerian territory!
